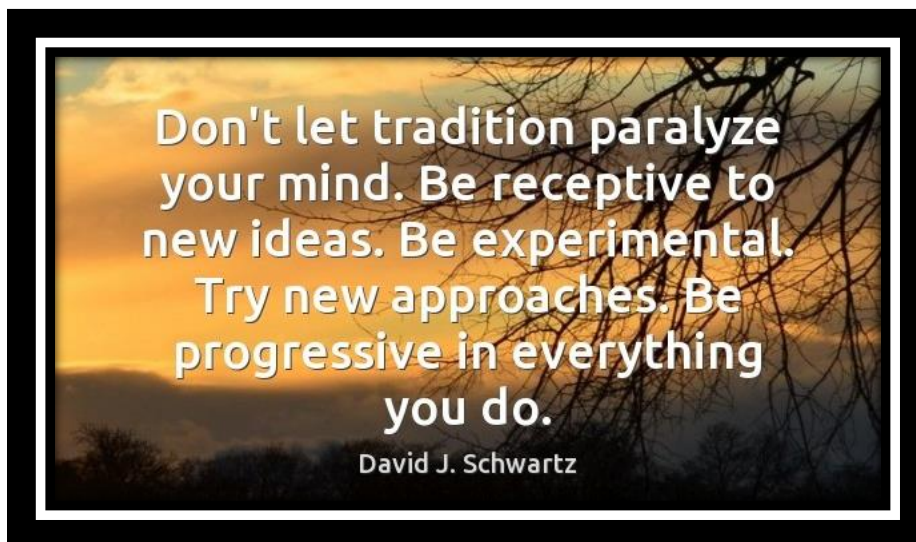
REFUNDS – because this event is strictly limited, refunds will only be issued for trial cancelation, or medical / veterinary reasons.

FastPass welcomes BIS

1. Handlers are required to notify the trial secretary they will be running a BIS at the event as soon as it is known
2. Competitors that have BIS will be allowed to withdraw and receive a full refund
3. Competitors will be notified there is a BIS on site
4. A protective mat shall be used at the start line. Competitors with a BIS must provide the mat themselves.
5. FastPass will allow the BIS to run without panties.
6. BIS will run as a group at the end of each class.
7. "BIS" will be noted next to the dog's name on the gate sheet so that other competitors, ring crew and the Judge(s) are aware.
8. BIS must use a designated separate relief area.
9. FastPass Agility allows any competitor wishing to withdraw (with refund given) due to BIS being on the premises.



Dogs must have an AAC ID card to compete at this trial

Measuring - Measuring will be done by laser. If your dog is under 2 years old or has not had their first measurement, you must have your dog measured. Limited measuring will be available on Friday at 5:00 pm, and Saturday/Sunday at 8:00 am. To limit unnecessary contact and to eliminate the need for measuring at every trial, judges will provide a one-time measure for dogs under 2 years. A temporary measurement card will be e-mailed to the handler to be used during this time. Dogs under 2 years of age may compete with their temporary card until they reach 2 years of age, at which point they will require an official measurement. Judges will resume signing Dog ID cards for dogs 2 years and older. Dogs over 2 years of age must be measured until they have their final height circled on their ID card.

Volunteering – All competitors are expected to volunteer. We will have a volunteer prize draw. Each event requires a 1 timer, 1 scribe, multiple course builders, and multiple ring crew. I am also hoping for a First Aid volunteer and a videographer.

Benching – Competitors are expected to bench dogs outside of the building. Limited seating area indoors. Well behaved dogs will be allowed on leash with human supervision in the seating area.

On Site Outdoor Field Area Etiquette: Unless your dog has 100% recall FastPass is requiring your dog to be always on leash in this area.

Move ups – we will do our best to accommodate move ups during the trial.

Ribbons – Ribbons will be awarded for placements 1st through 4th and there are ribbons for ADC, AADC, MADC, SGDC, AGDC, MGDC & ATChC. We will also have ribbons for other titles. If you are close to earning a title, please let us know in advance what you are hoping to achieve so we can ensure we have a ribbon available for you. If you do not take ribbons, you will receive an entry to a prize draw.

IT IS EVERYONE'S RESPONSIBILITY

- Follow the AAC code of conduct. ***The online entry includes the waiver.***
- Celebrate your teammates successes and support them when they struggle.
- Appreciate all judges, volunteers, hosts and competitors.
- You must not attend the trial if you are feeling unwell. You will be asked to leave the trial site immediately if you are visibly ill.
- Be respectful of other peoples' or dog's bubbles!
- Keep chairs in the designated seating area, do not block the aisles for dogs entering and exiting the ring.
- 100% recall required if you let your dog off leash in the outdoor field area.
- If an individual consistently disregards the guidelines, whether inadvertently or intentionally, it is everyone's responsibility to make sure unsafe behaviour is not permitted to continue, since it places everyone at risk. Individuals not complying with the trial protocols and measures may be asked to leave the trial.
- Respect the neighbours: control barking & be courteous if walking on the road.
- Read the entry form and the confirmation... they contain actual information.
